- 42 photovoltaic panels installed at Fyshwick Campus (\$100k)
- Sustainable House Sponsor, Bruce Campus (\$40k)
- Co-funded with CIT campus recycling (\$25k)
- LED/compact fluorescent lighting replacement program (\$12K)
- Natural Gas installation Bruce and Fyshwick canteens (\$10K)
- Purchase of gas appliances to replace electrical appliances (\$14K)
- · Solar Hot Water provided to all canteens in consultation with CIT
